We are writing to inform you of the Christian Values Enrichment Day for current Year 10 pupils.

Christian Values Enrichment Day: Runshaw College Sample Day – Monday 17 June 2024

On Monday 17 June 2024 we have arranged for pupils in the current Year 10 to be taken to Runshaw College in Leyland for an experience of what Post-16 education might be like once they leave St Michael's. We believe this hands-on experience is an invaluable step for our pupils as they consider their choices and aspirations.

Runshaw College is a well-respected and long established partner of the school. Over the last academic year pupils in Year 10 have been learning about the different pathways available in Post-16 education and this sampling opportunity will enable them to cement their understanding through a personal experience of different courses. All pupils have been provided the opportunity to select six subjects of interest, four of which they will experience on the day.

Transport for this trip is arranged and provided free of charge by Runshaw College and all pupils will receive a lunch voucher that will enable them to purchase food at any of the numerous food outlets at college. You are of course welcome to provide them with a small amount of cash in case they wish to purchase further items. We will depart from school around 9.30am and we will be back around 3:15pm to ensure that pupils will be able to catch the school buses home at the normal time.

If you state on the form that your child requires medication, or has a condition such as asthma which usually requires medication, they must bring their medication with them on the day of the visit. Unfortunately it will not be possible for us to take any pupils who do not have their medication with them. (Please note, it is likely we will also use this medical form for the future Christian Values Enrichment Day in September.)
