Other Parental Agreement and Consents

From time to time during the school year, your child may be involved in activities for which we require your consent. For one-off trips and visits, consent will be requested specifically for those activities. For others, such as walking to church or taking or using photographs and/or video footage of pupils, enduring consents be acknowledged. These will remain in place until your child leaves our school, or earlier if you choose to withdraw it.

Thank you to all of you who have acknowledged your consent level from the initial welcome letters sent out in March. We will also explain more about our Home School Agreement (copy overleaf) to your child when they join us in September.

We are very proud of all our pupils and we are keen to display all the varied activities and events they are involved in as well as celebrate all the personal achievements throughout the year. We are extremely thankful that the majority of parents/carers allow for this to happen whilst understanding that this just may not be appropriate or even possible for certain children.
