Scaled score – a scaled score of 100 would indicate that a pupil had met the expected level. The scaled scores in the table above show the average scaled score achieved by pupils within our school against the average scaled scores achieved by pupils across England.

Y4 Multiplications Table Check (10 pupils)

The average score our children achieved was 23.5 out of 25, with 30% achieving full marks.

The average score for children across the country was 20.6, with 34% achieving full marks.

Y1 Phonics Screening (9 pupils)

89% of our Y1 children achieved the pass mark for phonics, compared to a national average of 80%.

EYFS (7 pupils)

71% of our EYFS cohort achieved a 'good level of development', compared to a national average of 67.7%.
