OPERATION ENCOMPASS REMINDER FOR ALL SCHOOL PARENTS/CARERS



This is a reminder to parents/carers/families that school participates in Operation Encompass which is a unique Police and Education early intervention safeguarding partnership across Lancashire which ensures that a child/young person's school/ college is informed, prior to the start of the next school day, that there has been a domestic abuse, vulnerable child or missing incident to which the child or young person has been exposed, and which might then have
