BUMP TO HEAD WRIST BANDS FROM NEXT WEEK INSTEAD OF THE STICKERS.



To improve communication with home about any bumped head incident in school, children will given a blue wrist band which states that the child has had a bumped head rather than a sticker. A note will still go home with the child with symptoms to watch out for. Your child's class teacher should still see you at the end of the day to share with you about the injury.
