## **BUILDING WORKS AT SCHOOL OVER SUMMER**



Starting from next week, there will be builders on site in school and you will probably have seen their office on the school car park. School is fortunate to be part of a bid put together by Blackburn Diocese to improve the energy efficiency of schools. This work is funded by the government as part of their national decarbonisation programme. The flat roof facing the river (not including the infant classroom) is having additional insulation added,

the polycarbonate library roof is being replaced with a solid roof with Velux windows and an air source heat pump system is being installed to replace our very old oil boiler. We're hoping that in the future, solar panels will be added to the system but for now we're very thankful that the work is taking place and the government are covering the costs! The work should be completed by the end of the summer holidays. We've also had the wooden fence replaced in the infant outdoor area. We now have lovely blue powder coated railings and the old fence will be used to replace the aging wooden fence at the other end of the playground.

Our chickens hatched but unfortunately we only have four as several of the eggs didn't hatch. It was great to see so many children using 'Chick Cam' in the evenings while hatching was underway! **6<sup>th</sup> July – Our new vicar Rev Karen Herschell** is visiting school on the 6<sup>th</sup> of July. She is the vicar for the three churches in our benefice (Samlesbury, Balderstone and Mellor). She is keen to get to know everyone before September. This visit will take place outside in the school grounds so she can still meet everyone and maintain all social distancing guidelines.

As part of this service there will be a tree planting ceremony. If the covid risk assessment allow us to invite parents of children who are receiving an additional award then we will inform those parents the week before. (Please note that even if full restrictions are lifted nationally on the 19<sup>th</sup> July we will still be following the current social distancing guidelines for this service and in school. so that summer holiday plans for everyone in the school community are not put in jeopardy – thank you for your understanding in this matter).
