FOREST SCHOOL

After half-term, **Infant** Forest School sessions will be moving to **Wednesdays** which Mrs Kearns will continue to lead.

This is because the **Juniors** will start having Forest School sessions on **Tuesday** afternoons. Miss Myerscough will lead the KS2 sessions.

Year 6 will be the first year group to take part. Their sessions will be on 21st, 28th February and 7th March. Then it will be the turn of Y5s on 14th, 21st and 28th March. Those not at Forest School will have their PE lesson as usual.

In addition, both classes will be doing a full afternoon's session during the last week of half-term. For Y5/6 this will take place on Tuesday 7th February and for Y3/4 it will take place on Friday 10th February.

On Forest School days, pupils should come in their PE kits but must have trousers / joggers that cover their legs. They will need to bring welly boots; waterproofs and warm layers (including hats and gloves) to change into at lunchtime plus a bag to put muddy/wet clothes in afterwards!
