FOSS UPDATE—FRIENDS OF SAMLESBURY SCHOOL

FOSS held the annual AGM on the 28th October and would like to say thank you to everyone who supports FOSS events. I'd like to say a huge personal thank you to everyone on FOSS for the work you do. Over the last year FOSS has enabled school to buy: the Rhino Greenhouse, the school/church defibrillator (located in the school hall), subsidised the coach transport to the Christmas panto for the whole school, funded several software learning packages; a set of glockenspiels for music lessons; guided reading book sets; contributed to Year 6 leavers books; contributed to summer term coaches for class trips as well as providing new reception pupils starter welcome packs which include a reading book and a school reading bag.
