Overview of school formal assessments July 2025

EYFS

5/7 of our YR children achieved all of the Early Learning Goals (ELGS) = 71.4%

National figures are due to be published in November 2025.

Year 1 Phonics

5/7 (71.4%) of our Y1 children met the expected standard in the phonics screening.

Nationally, 80% of pupils achieved the pass mark.

Pupils who do not reach the expected standard at the end of Y1 attempt the screening again at the end of Y2. We had one pupil who needed to do this in 2025.

1/1 (100%) met the expected standard in the phonics screening by the end of Y2.

Nationally, 89% of pupils met the expected standard in the phonics screening by the end of Y2.

Key Stage 1 Results

There is no longer a requirement for pupils in Year 2 to complete SATs. We have chosen to use these, alongside teacher assessment judgements to make an overall final assessment of attainment in KSI. The national average comparisons are against those published in 2023 with the government no longer publishing results.

Y4 Multiplication Tables Check

3/10 (30%) of our pupils achieved 25 out of 25.

34% of pupils achieved full marks nationally.

21.3 out of 25 was the mean score for our Year 4 pupils.

The national average attainment mean score was 20.6 out of 25.

Y6 SATs

One child was absent for the SATs (representing 9.09%), so their results are automatically recorded as not having met the expected standard. This means the highest score we could achieve for any SATs test was 90.91%. The third column below shows what our actual results were for the children who completed the tests.
