SAM'S BIG SCOOT

RAISING FUNDS FOR UK CHILDREN'S FIRES RESEARCH



ORDINARY PEOPLE and an EXTRAORDINARY CHALLENGE



In memory of Sam, who tragically passed away in 2021 at the age of five from FIRES (Febrile Infection Related Epilepsy Syndrome), we are taking on an extraordinary challenge. Our goal is to raise £50,000 for UK FIRES research and to increase awareness of this catastrophic and devastating syndrome.

On Friday, 20th September 2024, we will KICK SCOOT 44 MILES from Aston University in BIRMINGHAM, home of the first and only UK FIRES research, to Sam's hometown of DERBY.

OUR JOURNEY:

- Three days, two nights
- Overnight stops in Lichfield and Burton on Trent
- No electric scooters, just sheer determination!

THE TEAM:

A core team will scoot for three consecutive days, supported by a tag team joining for full or half days. On the final day, many of Sam's friends and supporters will join us as we scoot into his hometown.

SAM'S SPIRIT:

Sam is the heart and soul of this challenge. He adored his red scooter and rode it everywhere. Rachel, Sam's mum, will carry that scooter on her back throughout the challenge, ensuring he is very much part of the team!

Support our mission to fund UK FIRES research and raise awareness. Together, we can fight this devastating syndrome!



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
WHAT IS FIRES?

FIRES, or Febrile Infection Related Epilepsy Syndrome, is a rare and catastrophic condition that affects healthy children with no prior history of epilepsy or seizures. The seizures begin suddenly and explosively following a simple febrile infection or virus, rapidly progressing into relentless seizure activity that is exceptionally difficult to stop. Children often remain in an induced coma for weeks to months, with lifechanging impacts. One in five children die during the acute stage, and those who survive often suffer significant neurological disabilities and life-long epilepsy.

There are currently children fighting FIRES in the UK; with two cases in the East Midlands during the last year.

ABOUT OUR SAM

Sam was beautiful, kind, loving, caring and joyful. He adored cuddling up to his dog Daisy and exploring the great outdoors. Shy with people he didn't know, he was articulate and had wisdom beyond his years. Sam loved superheroes and making his family and many friends laugh! He was a healthy child and rarely ill, but just after his 5th birthday, Sam and his family were catapulted head-first into a battle to save his life from the sudden onset of FIRES. After a sevenweek fight in paediatric critical care at Queen's Medical Centre in Nottingham, our beautiful Sam passed away due to catastrophic and irreversible brain damage, caused by his relentless seizure activity.



OUR GOALS

The **first** is to raise awareness of FIRES to attract more research. It's not yet understood what causes FIRES, and there are no known effective treatments. Despite this, the UK's first and only FIRES research didn't start until 2023. Our **second** goal is to raise as much money as possible to help fund further research. Whilst we could not save Sam, we need to try and save other children. Support this challenge, and you could help save children's lives...**what an IMPACT!**

Sam's Superheroes Foundation was founded to ensure Sam's life continues to make a difference in the world for years to come. We fund animal assisted therapies and creative activities, support FIRES research and offer grants to families affected by FIRES. We recently applied to become a Registered Charity with the Charity Commission.

A few of the activities we have recently funded for young people include: animal assisted grief workshops, horse therapy programmes, 1,800 hospital activity packs, activities for the play therapists at Nottingham's QMC Hospital, grants for two UK FIRES families and delivered therapy dog services to schools.



SAM'S DOG

Daisy, Sam's black labrador, plays a leading role in our charity through her transformative therapy dog work with young people. She came into Sam's life as a puppy, when he was two years old. It was love at first sight and they were joined at the hip from that point onwards! She is loving, kind, joyful, calm and caring - just like Sam.

Daisy makes astounding impact in her work, connecting with children in ways adults simply can't. She spreads Sam's love and energy in the world, making children smile wherever she goes. We are proud she has reached the final of BBC Radio Derby's Local Hero Awards 2024 for her work. The final is in September so watch this space!



SAM'S MUM

Sam's mother, Rachel, is committed to **#FindACureForFIRES**. Since Sam died she has been sharing Sam's FIRES story with doctors, researchers and the wider community to raise awareness and support the critical need for research.



In 2023, Rachel was a guest speaker at the <u>NORSE Institute's</u> International Conference, which was founded by Nora Wong who lost her son from FIRES in 2013. The NORSE Institute is the leading global expert on FIRES. This year she shared <u>Sam's story</u> at the UK's Epilepsy Research Institute's Reception in London where she also introduced the dedicated researchers leading the very first <u>UK FIRES Research</u> study.


