

Assessment Procedure for Parents

<p>In September students complete a baseline assessment to find out what they know for each subject. Once marked Recovery Lead identify students who are below where they should be in 4 subjects to work with. Class teachers identify 5 students from each year group to work with and support.</p>		
<p>Fortnightly recall quizzes set in all subjects to identify weaknesses</p>		
<p>Assessment each term completed and reported to parents/carers at the end of the term.</p>	<p>Assessments at key points across the Academic Year which are then reported to parents/carers. Reports are made live on Bromcom towards the end of each term.</p>	
<p>Assessments follow a set-up of: 25% recall knowledge questions 75% application task</p> <p>Scores = Mastery Statement</p> <p>Emerging - 0-30% Developing - 31-45% Secure- 46-60% Advancing - 61-75% Exceptional - 75% +</p>	<p>Assessments follow a set-up of: 25% recall knowledge questions 75% application task</p> <p>2019 grade boundaries used (for 75% exam-based element)</p>
