Unifrog



Unifrog is a "one-stop-shop" online platform for students (Years 7-13) to explore career paths, subjects, and pathways like university, apprenticeships, and college, helping them research, compare, and apply for their "best next step" after school. It offers tools for skills/personality quizzes, building CVs/personal statements, finding opportunities (UK & international), and managing applications, making it a comprehensive tool for future planning.

Students can sign in via unifrog.org and sign in with their school email and a chosen password (this is not set to their school password).
