



# Classroom Behaviour Pathway

- Follow our way.
- Wear your uniform correctly.
- Arrive on time to lesson.
- Bring the necessary equipment/kit/ingredients.
- Bags and coats to be under the table or on the back of the chair.
- Sit up straight on chairs (four legs on the floor, face the front, knees under the table).
- Follow all instructions and complete your work to a good standard whilst taking pride in your presentation.
- Be polite and respectful to your peers and staff members.
- Contribute positively to all aspects of the lesson.

You will receive positive points and verbal praise for demonstrating good conduct.

These points contribute to the termly rewards event.

**1st warning** - verbal with clear instructions around how to rectify behaviour.

**2nd warning** for the same or any other behaviour - a **matrix removal** and -4 points.

- Little or no work produced.
- Getting out of your seat without permission.
- Shouting out/not putting your hand up when contributing to the lesson.
- Talking when other people are.
- Off task behaviour or causing a distraction to other students or the teacher.
- Not sitting up straight on your chair properly.
- Chewing gum.
- Uniform not worn properly.
- Swearing or inappropriate language, not directed at another person.

The following behaviours carry specific sanctions but are not part of the matrix removal protocol.

| • 3+ minutes late to lesson.            | -1 points  |
| • Late after register is finished.      | -2 points  |
| • Lack of equipment/kit/ingredients.    | -2 points missing equipment.                                 |
| • Jewellery worn and refusal to remove. | On call team contacted to confiscate.                        |
| • Use of phone or electrical equipment. | -2 points and confiscation of phone or electronic equipment. |

- Persistent failure to correct behaviour.
- Throwing items in the classroom.
- Leaving the class without permission.
- Threatening/dangerous behaviour or aggression.
- Verbal abuse.
- Damage to Academy property including books.
- Refusing to follow a sanction or total refusal to comply.
- Online safety offence.
- Truancy of a lesson.
- Refusal to hand over phone or electrical device.

Consequences may include:

- Immediate matrix removal.
- Time in isolation the next day.
- Behaviour meeting with parents and staff.
- Managed move/alternative provision.

Sanctions issued by the Principal only:

- Suspension
- Permanent exclusion
