## Year 10

## Year 11

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| Autumn | Understanding the skills, attributes and values required to give care in a range of health settings, and for varying needs, abilities and illnesses.                              |
| Spring | PSA coursework writeups and resubmissions at the end of the term, Learners will also explore the factors that affect health and wellbeing as part of the exam topic introduction. |
| Summer | Understanding the physiological and lifestyle indicators to health, and person-centred approaches to make recommendations to improve an individual's health and wellbeing.        |

## Year 12

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| Autumn | Learners cover physical, intellectual, emotional and social development across the human lifespan, and the factors affecting development and the effects of ageing.  |
| Spring | Learners focus on the principles and practicalities that underpin meeting individuals' care and support needs, which are the foundation of all the care disciplines. |
| Summer | Feedback, improvements and resubmission of spring coursework along with any re-takes of earlier exam units.  |

## Year 13

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| Autumn | Learners explore what it is like to work in the health and social care sector, including the roles and responsibilities of workers and organisations.                                     |
| Spring | Learners explore key theoretical perspectives that have been put forward on psychological and physical development and how they are applied in different health and social care settings. |
| Summer | Feedback, improvements and resubmission of spring coursework along with any re-takes of earlier exam units.   |
