Dear Parents and Carers,

Sadly, we have been advised by the NEU that further industrial action is planned for Tuesday, 5th and Wednesday, 6th May 2026. The school will be open to Y11, 13 and a small number of year 12 students who have external exams in the near future (separate invite to follow) but closed to other year groups.

I apologise for the continued disruption caused by the strike action. We will continue to update you and let you know of any further developments.

We recognise the disruption this may cause to families and to the daily routines that support good attendance and progress. We will continue to work with the NEU and ACAS to resolve outstanding concerns and hope that a resolution can be agreed that will positively impact the long-term education, stability and life chances of both current and future students.

To ensure continuity of learning, online work will be set for all affected year groups, and links will be shared via the MCAS app. If your child does not have access to a suitable device at home, please contact enquiries@tscacademy.org.uk so that we can provide an alternative method of accessing work.

We will remain open for a small number of students from the affected year groups where attendance on site is essential for safeguarding reasons or where home access to learning is not possible. These students will complete supervised online work in a designated space. Thank you for your understanding and continued support.
