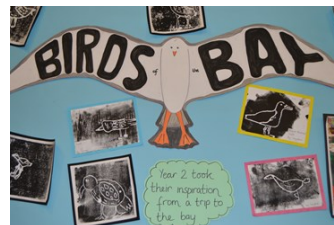
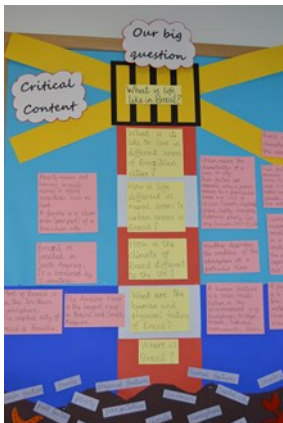

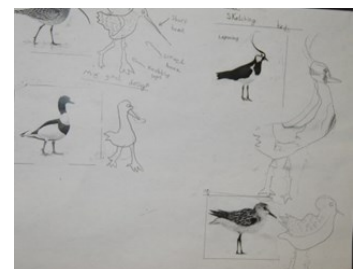
Curriculum News
