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# PREPARING FOR POST-19







## YEAR 9

All pupils from Year 9 onwards have individual Preparation for Adulthood (PfA) targets, working towards their potential outcomes. These are linked to their EHCPs Pupil Views are gathered with a PfA focus.

# **YEAR 10/11**

Transition annual reviews will be held in the Summer of Yr10 or Autumn of Yr11. Pupils could move to colleges if they prefer of stay at Saxon Hill. LA will send letters to families to confirm

# YEAR 11/12/13

Continued focus on individual PfA targets Discussions at annual review about possible post-19 options for each individual. Social care transition team may start to attend reviews. Health support will move across to adult services

# **AUTUMN YR 14**

Transition review completed by the end of this term. A decision about next steps is based on whether a pupil is to continue with education or attend a social care setting.

# **SPRING YR 14**

If continuing education, the agreed placement will be confirmed this term Decisions about care settings may take longer. If a pupil moves to a care setting, the LA will no longer continue the EHCP as all support will be provided through social care and/or health.



# **SUMMER YR 14**

Transition support will be provided through meetings and visits - planned around each individual. Pupils will be presented with their certificates at our Leavers Assmebly.



# **Preparing for Post-19- Additional Information**

- We hold transition events every year and we recommend that if possible, families start to attend from Year 9 onwards so that they can start to think about options. This can feel quite over-whelming but the earlier you start to learn about the processes, the more prepared you will hopefully feel and we are here to support you.
- If you would like your child to remain at Saxon Hill for Yr 12 onwards, the local authority (LA) will send you a letter to ask you your preference. Please let us know well before Yr11 if you think that you would like your child to move to a new setting at the end of Yr11 so that we can support you and inform the LA as soon as possible.



If your child has not had a social care assessment before, we can help by making a referral to the transition team. We will support you where possible through these changes of services and our school nursing team can also offer advice and support.

If you are hoping for a college place for your child, you have to apply direct to the setting. The LA will send the paperwork to them as a consultation as well. The earlier you do this the better as places can go very quickly in the Autumn term.


