- Being mindful of your own behaviours in relation to our pupils

- Tell the pupil what you are doing and why
- Do not investigate

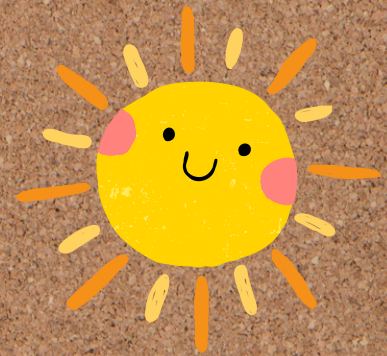
