Topic

This half-term, our topic is City or Countryside. Throughout the course of the term, we will be exploring what it's like in the city and in the countryside, comparing what the similarities and differences are between them and seeing which one we prefer!

Communication, Language and Literacy

In English this term, we will be learning all about stories with recurring phrases (such as the Gruffalo and We're Going on a Bear Hunt), creating and following instructions and exploring some poetry!

Independence and Wellbeing

In our PHSE lessons, we will be learning all about Rules and the Law, looking at why they are in place as well as the consequences that occur if we don't follow them. After half-term, we will be learning about people who are special to us.

Thinking and Problem Solving

In our Maths this half-term, we will be learning all about Position and Direction. After half-term, we will be looking at Patterns and Sequencing then Money.
