As Hub 1, we also support and work alongside food bank, supplying donated food to those in need. We sort donations based on packaging, checking whether they're out of date and even more!

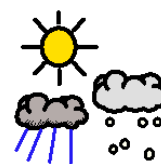
Drinks and snacks
