Communication

In Communication, we will be focusing on the AQA unit: A Sensory View of the Beano Comic.

Pupils will participate in sensory stories, enjoy mark making activities, sequence narratives and possibly make their own!



Thinking and Problem Solving

We will be focusing on the AQA unit ICT for a purpose: we will be exploring lots of equipment, such as the sound beam, iPad, interactive programmes using the whiteboard and communication aids. Pupils will participate in exploring how to operate all these for a given purpose, such as communicating, making different sounds and taking photographs (look out for these on EFL)

Our Aim unit will be focusing on addition using numbers up to 20. We will be learning to identify words, phrases and symbols used in addition and matching calculations in digits to calculations in words.



AQA / AIM

Pupils in Hub 2 will either be working towards AIM or AQA accreditations, please ask the class teacher if unsure on what these are and if you want to know more.

PSHE

PSHE sessions this term will be focusing on medication and pupils personal medical supports. Pupils will look at different medication routes, what medication they may have and why as well as roleplaying the delivery of medication.
