Communication, language and Literacy.

This term we will be completing work towards our AQA unit– Speaking and communicating our opinions in the world. We will be following discussions and making relevant contributions using our preferred communication aids, surrounding the book the Demon Dentist, which comes under this terms theme—work around the world.

Thinking and problem solving.

This term our AQA unit - Practical Cooking will allow us to gain knowledge of different equipment and use it for it's intended purpose. Will we be following visual and verbal instructions to set timers and operate cooking appliances.

Hydro and Rebound

We work on a department rota, where our Hydro and Rebound sessions will be completed on a Friday, between the Hub groups. You will receive a message in your child's home diary when it is their week, so you are able to provide the kit required.

Vocational

Throughout the year and years to come, there will be a variety of opportunities to access the range of vocational opportunities we have in school. These include work at the Craft-barn and Farm. While in the school setting the pupils will complete a year long AQA Unit 'Creating a personal profile with support'. AQA Unit– completing odd jobs and this terms new addition, investigating jobs, which will allow time to research different job roles within school and take part in a sort work experience session.

Community and the wider world.

This term will we be continuing with the AQA Unit– Exploring the local area. We will complete sensory walks, Community tuff trays, Looking at maps to explore the school grounds and forest school to engage with both natural and man-made features.

Weather

As the weather can vary so much, we do ask that you send you're child with the appropriate clothing,, sun hats, sun cream, coats, gloves and woolly hats when needed. We also ask that all belongings are named, to avoid items getting lost.
