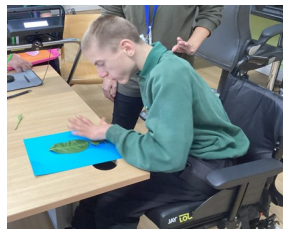

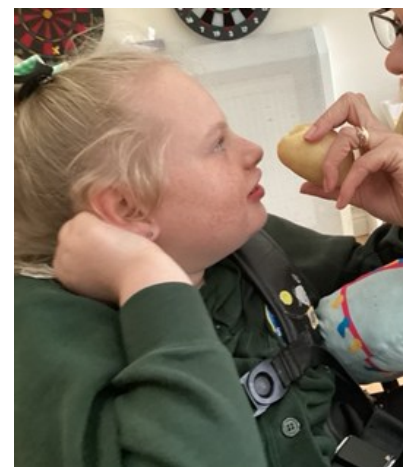




## Our Activities this week...
