

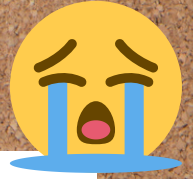

Congratulations

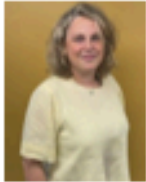


Dear Families,
