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An appeal from one of our parents

Hi. My name is Keleigh and I'm a mommy to my beautiful daughter Gracie. When Gracie was born everything was a dream, I was a mommy, Gracie was the most beautiful baby and I couldn't believe how lucky i was. But when Gracie turned 2 we realised something wasn't quite right, she wasn't hitting milestones like her peers, it was a worrying time, she started to get uneasy on her feet & become petrified to even stand up. We fought through all of the health professionals to get answers, and finally they listened. When gracie turned 4 we finally got a diagnosis. RETT SYNDROME. our world shattered, Gracie's narrowed. Our hearts broke but we couldn't do anything. We were helpless. But we did our best.

Gracie is now nearly 11 , and with her regressive disorder, she has lost the ability to walk, talk, use her hands or even stand.

shes such a happy bright girl and doesn't let anything get her down. She suffers with epilepsy & heart conditions, she can't tell us when she's in pain, she can't talk to her little brother, she can't play games. She's stuck in her own body, trapped.

Gracie had the chance to use an EYE-GAZE at school and she blew us all away, being cheeky telling people to massage her feet & hurry up to feed her because she's hungry and so much more, her world opened up again, she could tell school when she was in pain, when she had a headache. She was free.

unfortunately an EYE-GAZE device is costly and out of our price range. we've reached out to a charity who can help with funding towards what she needs.

but we really need your help to part fund it too.

I wouldn't usually do a go fund me, unless I was really despstate for your help. so please any spare penny, pound will help us towards getting our Gracie's voice back. Thankyou for taking the time to read.
