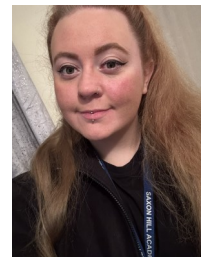

English

In English, we will be focusing on Classic Children's Literature and Biographies.

We will be focusing on a classic fantasy story: The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe. We will use this story to support us in developing our descriptive language and sentence writing.



Maths

Science

This half term in science, our topic is light. We will be making the most of sunny days ahead, going outside, making shadows, looking at reflections as well as looking at the light sources we have inside.

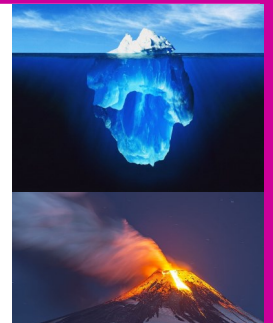
Next half term, we will be looking at sound and how it travels.



Topic

Our Anchor for this term is 'Icebergs/Volcanoes'. In the first half of the summer term we will focus on icebergs, looking closely at the features of ice, carrying out experiments around melting, noticing how icebergs are formed and of course, making our own ice lollies!

In Summer 2, we will be looking very closely at volcanoes, that means using science to make volcanic eruptions and looking at different volcanoes from around the world!
