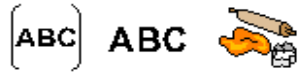

Communication, Language and Literacy

In English this term, we will be completing work towards our AQA accreditation component 2 - Heroism - which focuses on fiction texts and links into our anchor - Making Connections.

Throughout the year, we have explored lots of different authors and books. This term, we are continuing with the events of *The Diary of a Wimpy Kid!*



Thinking and Problem Solving

During Maths this term, we will be working on 2 units towards the AQA accreditation. During Summer 1, we are revisiting the 4 Operations. Summer 2, we will be completing the unit of Calendar and Time.

As well as this, we will have different opportunities to apply our Maths skills into the real world with our Vocational opportunities.

In Science this term, there will be more of a Physics focus. Throughout this component, pupils will be exploring energy, forces and the structure of matter.
