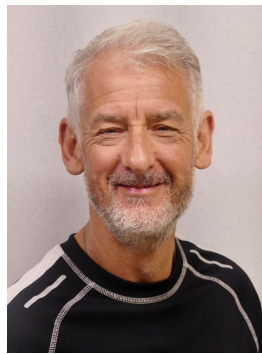

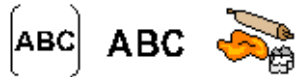

Communication, Language & Literacy

This term, we will begin our new text, "A Murder Most Unladylike," by Robin Stevens. Pupils will complete activities linking with the text, alongside our new literacy AQA Unit, "Maintaining Relationships: Communication", exploring different means of communication as ways to converse with their peers.



Thinking & Problem Solving

Vocational Subjects
