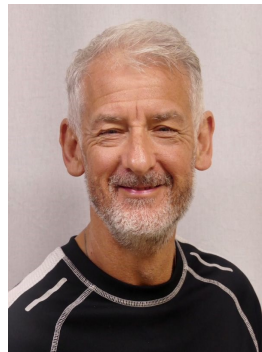

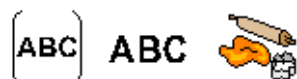

Communication, Language & Literacy

This term, we will begin our AQA unit on Careers in Transport. Pupils will be focusing on a different mode of transport every two week, We will aim for this to be as immersive as possible, through sensory stories, story massage and sensory exploration of transport themed resources.

Vocational Subjects

Our vocational AQA units this term are Sensory Cooking, Hobbies & Pastimes and Raising Funds for a Charity

Sensory Cooking will provide great opportunities for literacy and problem solving, as pupils will be encouraged to identify ingredients, measure amounts using appropriate equipment and follow instructions from a recipe. It also ties in nicely with our PFA focus, teaching pupils essential life skills.

I am very excited for our Hobbies & Pastimes unit, especially as it will link well with our Hobbies & Leisure topic. Pupils will be encouraged to explore different leisure activities in class, making choices on what they wish to participate in and communicating their preferences using PODD and switches..

Pupils will be continuing their work with the Rotary Interact Club, raising funds for new eye gaze technology in school. Keep an eye out in the home-school diaries for news of our latest fundraising project!
