### Communication, Language & Literacy

This term, we will begin our AQA Fiction unit, focusing on 'spooky sensory stories'. Pupils will be studying Macbeth and The Raven before half term. followed by A Christmas Carol and Frankenstein after half term. Our communication focus will be on using symbols to make choices and share ABC ABC preferences.

### Thinking & Problem Solving

This term, we will begin our AQA Using a Switch unit. Pupils will develop their use of different types of switches, with a Preparing for Adulthood focus. We will be encouraging pupils to use switches to complete different tasks, such as boiling a kettle, turning the light on, etc. This will be a fabulous opportunity for pupils to increase their independence in controlling their own

environment.



### **Vocational Studies**

Our vocational AQA units this term are "A Sensory Introduction to Hobbies" and "Out & About in the Community." Both of these units link nicely with our overarching 'anchor' for the autumn term, which is "Personal Growth".

During our Hobbies unit, pupils will be encouraged to explore different leisure activities in class, making choices on what they wish to participate in and communicating their preferences using PODD and switches.

I am very excited about our new community unit, as this will provide us with plenty of opportunities to explore our local area. Watch this space for details of our next class trip!

This term, some pupils will be attending work experience at the Craft Barn every Friday. We will let you know if this is your child.
