Our Topic


Our topic this term, is "A day in the life of a musician'. We will be exploring different types of music, different instruments and will be making our own instruments. In creativity, we will be exploring the great

If you child likes a particular music please let us know and we can explore this in class.



Throughout the week, we will be having therapy and sensory based sessions, which will include the following -


Write dance, sound bath, story massage, sensory story, dance massage, as well as our topic sessions. Please see weekly timetable which is sent with this newsletter.

<u>News switches</u> - We will be sending home a news switch with your child which will have news of what they have enjoyed recorded on. To listen to the message, hold the switch upside down and slide the black button to play and then press the top of the switch with the photo on down.

If you would like to record a message on the switch, slide the black button on the bottom to record, press the top of the switch down and hold down, as you talk into the switch. When you have finished, release the switch and slide the black button to either off or play.
