English


In Summer 1 English, we will be covering 'Stories with recurring literary language' where we will compare our topic books on



Lichfield to Towns, countryside and places within Lichfield. In Summer 2 we will be focusing on Play Scripts. As part of regular English sessions throughout the week we will be covering phonics, spellings, reading and writing practice.

Maths

In Summer 1 Maths, we will be learning all about Position and Direction, beginning with



prepositions and in Summer 2 we will be covering Pattern and Sequencing! We also

develop number skills once a week through practical activities and games.

Science

In Science Summer 1 we will be learning about rocks. We will be looking at fossils and exploring and responding to a range of different rocks.



During Summer 2 we will be looking at 'States of Matter', comparing and grouping materials according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. Exploring, showing a curiosity and responding to a range of solids, liquids and gases.
