Communication and Language

We will be learning to:

- Listen in familiar and new situations.
- Understand and answer 'how' and 'why' questions.
- Make relevant comments when listening to stories.
- Follow instructions with 2 parts, in familiar situations.
- Use the words 'and' and 'then' in our talk.
- Retell a simple past event.

Literacy

We will be learning to:

- Know all the sounds in Phase 2 phonics.
- Blend known letters to read words.
- Segment words for spelling.
- Read the words I, the, is, put, pull, full, as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to, into, she, he, we, me, be
- Use some recognisable letters in our writing.
- Write our own name, forming each letter correctly.
- Recognise we need a space between words.

Understanding The World

We will be learning to:

- Compare objects, noticing similarities and differences.
- Understand language related to history e.g. old, long time ago, in the past, now.
- Talk about and compare different celebrations.
- Explore forces through pushes and pulls

- Understand the school KIND values.

Physical Development

We will be learning to:

- Build our finger strength to support our handwriting and improve our pencil grip.
- Copy patterns and letters.
- Do up/ undo zips and buttons with greater independence.
- Push, roll and bounce a ball with increasing control.

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Count objects carefully and accurately.
- Find different ways to make 2,3,4 and 5.
- Compare amounts.
- Begin to understand the concept of 'part' and 'whole'.
- Identify and describe shapes with 4 sides.
- Explore the passing of time.
- Understand and use positional language.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning to:

- Name colours and identify different shades of the same colour.
- Explore how different materials feel and how they can be used.
- Use scissors safely, cutting in a straight line.
- Use brushes to make lines, circles and spirals.
