Communication and Language

We will be learning to:

Listen attentively and respond to what we hear with relevant questions, comments or actions

Understand and use a range of words to describe time, shape, texture, size

Speak clearly in well-formed sentences

Offer explanations for why things might happen

Express ideas and feelings about experiences

Use past, present and future tenses in conversations with peers and adults

Use conjunctions e.g. if, so because, could.
