Communication and Language

We will be learning to:

- Ask questions to find out more and check our understanding
- Retell and recreate our own stories.

Literacy

We will be learning to:

- Retell a story in the correct sequence
- Give a simple opinion on a book we have read
- Predict how an unknown story might end
- Recall all phase 3 GPCs and read words containing 2 or more digraphs
- Read and spell tricky words taught so far
- Think of our own sentences, say them out loud then have a go at writing them down
- Form more letters correctly and begin to use ascenders and descenders.

Physical Development

We will be learning to:

- Hold a pencil effectively
- Add details to drawings showing care and accuracy
- Form letters correctly
- Move with confidence and control, combining movements with ease and fluency
- Respond to words and music using our bodies.

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Compare numbers and amounts.
- Explore the composition of numbers to 10
- Combine two groups to find the total
- Recognise and write numbers to at least 10
- Use the language of doubles
- Explore odd and even numbers
- Explore 3D shapes.
- Copy and create repeating patterns.
- Explore and compare length and height
- Talk about, order and sequence time

- Notice signs of spring.
- Find out about and compare life, communities, animals and climate in different countries
- Locate places on a map/ globe
- Talk about lives of people around us and their roles in society
