English

Maths

We will be learning:

PE

Science

Animals Including Humans

History/Geography

This half term we will be looking at life in Ancient Egypt and the importance of different jobs. We will also be looking at the impact Ancient Egypt had on the world today

Art/DT

In DT this half term we will be designing our own structures. We will be looking at important features that structures need and how they can be stable.
