PE

Our PE sessions this half term will focus on Athletics

This will be in preparation for Sports day and will include running, jumping and obstacles.

Science

In our science lessons we will be learning about sound. Children will learn how to identify how sounds are made, recognise that vibrations from sounds travel from the medium to the ear; find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produces it and also recognise that sound decreases as the distance increases.

This half term, we will be focusing on Geography and looking at where food comes from and the impact our food choices has on the environment.
