

Half Term Overview

English

As part of our comprehension work, we will continue to read Wolf Brother by Michelle Paver. As part of this work, we will:

- Study extracts from the text.
- Complete VIPERS comprehension questions.
- Learn how to structure detailed answers

Through our writing work, we will produce a survival narrative and a survival guide linked to the text: The Lost Book of Adventure.

Maths

We will develop our knowledge and skills in the following areas:

- Decimals and percentages
- Perimeter and Area
- Statistics

We will also continue to work on our arithmetic, reasoning & problem solving and investigative skills.

Computing

In this unit, Vector Drawings, we will:

- Learn how to use drawing tools.
- Recognise that images in vector drawings are created using shapes and lines, and each individual element in the drawing is called an object.
- Layer objects and begin grouping and duplicating them.

Science

This half term, we will complete our work on 'Living Things and their Habitats.' In this unit, we will:

- Describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird.
- Describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

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DE

We will develop our PE skills in the following fields:

- Cricket
- Athletics

We will consider how to use tactics and think about how individual performance can contribute to whole team outcomes.

PSHE

This half term, we will study relationships.

Through the unit, we will:

- Examine the importance of self-esteem and ways this can be boosted.
- Reflect upon a variety of online and offline contexts, including gaming and social networking.

History/Geography

In Geography, we will continue to study South America. As part of this unit, we will:

- Examine geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography in a region within South America (Farming Comparative Study)
- Use fieldwork to observe, measure and record human and physical features in the local area

Art/DT

In Art, we will continue our Shadow Puppet project. We will:

- Make shadow puppets thinking about how the qualities of the materials used affect the outcome.
- Manipulate the materials using tools so that the puppets have character and expression.
- Make puppets move in simple ways by articulating them.

RE

This half term we will learn what Christians believe about old and new covenants. Within this, we will:

- Explore the covenants between God and key figures in the Bible including Abraham, Moses, and David.
- Compare different faiths and their belief systems.
