English

Reading:

Our class book is 'Stay Where You Are and Leave' by John Boyle. We will carry out comprehension work linked to this text. We will also be carrying out comprehension work linked to other areas of the curriculum. We will be practising SAT style questions.

Writing:

We will link our writing to the text 'A Story Like the Wind' by Gill Lewis. We will write a flashback narrative and a newspaper report.

Science
