

Half Term Overview

English

Reading:

As part of our reading comprehension, we will read our new class novel, Cogheart. We will also read extracts and answer reading comprehension questions in preparation for the SATs Reading Paper.

Writing: We will write a balanced argument outlining the advantages and disadvantages of reintroducing wolves into the UK and a narrative piece about a hunter. We will also use the text, 'Shackleton's Journey' as a stimulus for a piece of writing.

Maths

Arithmetic: Daily arithmetic practice. **Quick Maths:** During our quick maths sessions, we will revisit the concepts taught in preparation for the upcoming SATs.

Our new learning will include a geometry unit and some work on position and movement. As part of this, we will revise our knowledge of angles and extend our learning to include vertically opposite angles. We will also learn how to translate and reflect shapes in 4 quadrants.

Computing

In ICT, the children will be learning about 3D modelling.

PE
