English

Reading: We will start our new class novel: 'All the things that could go wrong' by Stewart Foster.

We will look at extracts from the text to develop our comprehension skills.

Writing: In our first unit, we will write a dual narrative based on Hansel and Gretel by Nick Gaiman.

We will also make an information leaflet about a fictious venue that is based on Mission Out.

Drama: We will be studying a playscript, with a big emphasis on drama, in preparation for our end of year performance.

PF

In PE, we will develop and practice our rounders skills. We will also look at a variety of athletics events and refine our techniques in preparation for competitions

PSHE

This half term, our unit is 'Changing Me'. During the sessions we will look at the physical changes that take place during puberty as well as practical ways in which we can prepare for the transition to secondary school.

Science

In science, we will learn about light. As part of this topic, we will recognise that light appears to travel in a straight line and use this knowledge to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye. We will also explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.

History/Geography

In history, we will continue to learn about Africa (past and present) and the development of the slave trade. The unit will also explore Britain's role in the transatlantic slave trade.
