

# Half Term Overview

### Enalish

In our English lessons, we will develop our skills in orally rehearsing sentences and recording accurately. We will learn spelling rules for changing singular nouns into plurals and explore expanding sentences using the conjunction 'and' to join clauses.

Our focus in handwriting will be practicing the correct orientation of letters and consistent sizing.

In Phonics we will continue to follow Little Wandle to gain confidence in reading and spelling phonetic and tricky words.

Reading will involve sessions focused on developing the skills of decoding, prosody and comprehension.

### Maths

The focus in number is around addition and subtraction within 10.

We will continue to use the symbols <> and = to compare

statements. We will explore fact families and number bonds to 10. We will learn to read, write and interpret sums involving addition (+), and equals (=) signs. We will look at part- whole models and explore ways of finding missing parts when adding and subtracting. We will also begin to recognise, name and sort 3D and 2D shape and begin to identify and create patterns using shapes.

# Computing

In computing learners will develop their understanding of a range of tools used for digital painting. The unit concludes with learners considering their preferences when painting with and without the use of digital devices.

### PF / Music

With Mrs. McKay we will be exploring the dance unit of 'growing.' There will be a focus on responding to rhythm and music. We will create motifs and sequences and gaining confidence with performing.

With Mrs. Stitchman we will be developing our ball skills with a focus on sending and receiving techniques. In our music lessons we will be exploring *Colonel Hathi's march' from* The Jungle Book.

### **PSFD**

In our Jigsaw lessons we will be learning about celebrating differences and building healthy, positive friendships.

### Science

In science we will identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.

### RE
