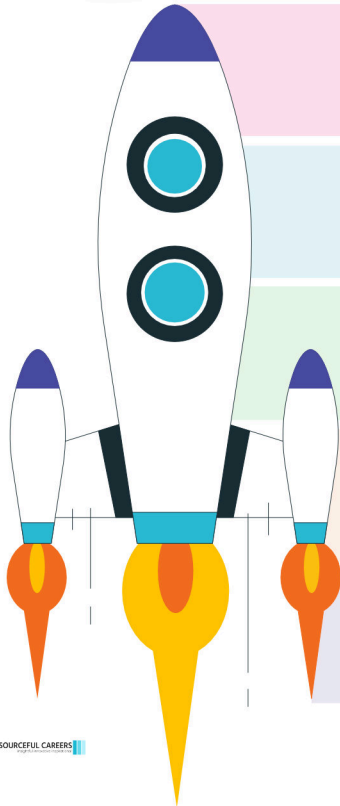
Understand Different Cultures

Be Creative & Flexible

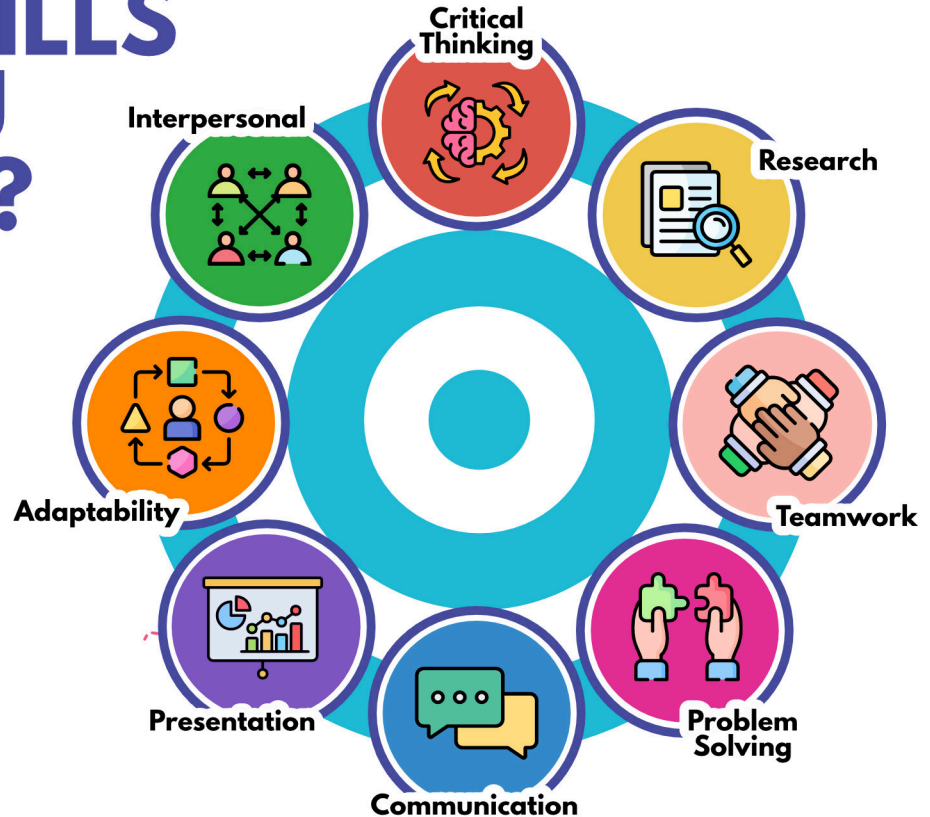

Supports producers by finding information, people and places for television or radio programmes.

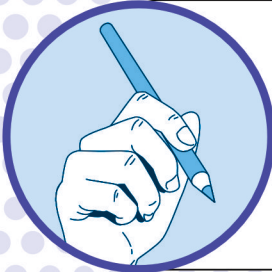
