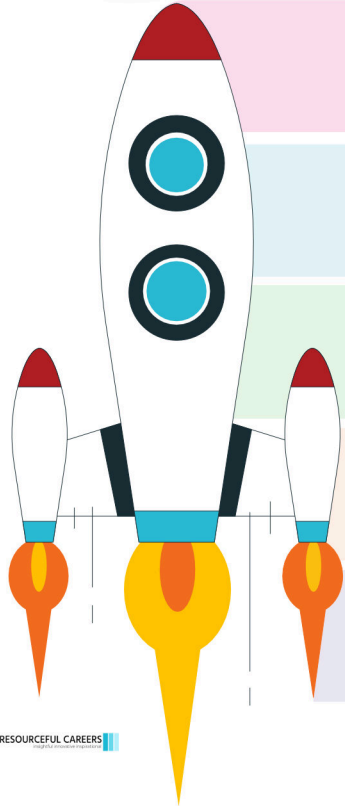

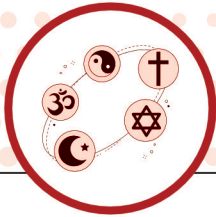
Different jobs need different skills but did you know studying **Religious Studies** can help you to develop these skills.

CHAPLAIN

Provide support, guidance and practical help to people both with and without faith, often during times of crisis or personal difficulty.

£22,000 - £50,000



HEALTH SERVICE MANAGER

Manage the cost, delivery and quality of healthcare services in the NHS or private healthcare sector.

£25,000 - £40,000



PSYCHOTHERAPIST

Help clients explore and express their thought processes, feelings and behaviour.

£35,000 - £68,000

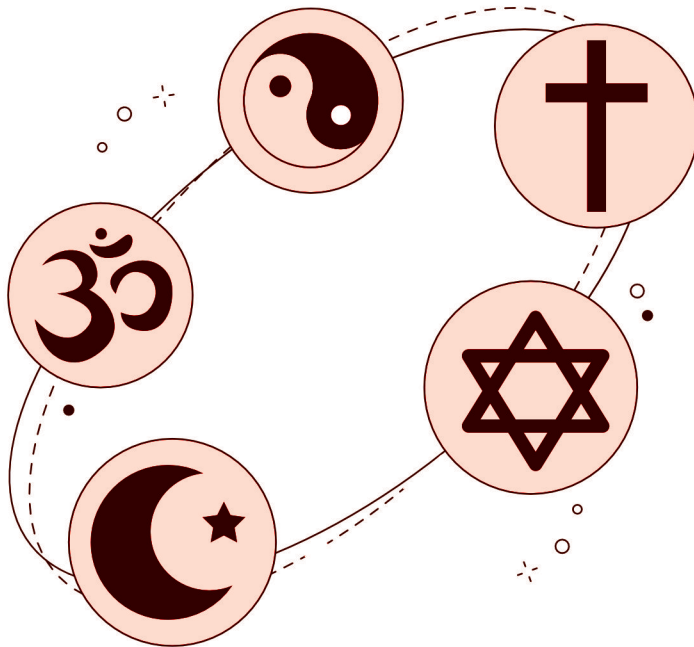
