Thank you for agreeing to your child attending the visit to the Harry Potter Warner Brothers Studio Tour on one of the following dates:

- Monday 26 January
- Wednesday 28 January
- Thursday 29 January

As you are aware, the **final payment is due on Friday 16 January 2026.**

Here are just a few reminders for the trip. Your child will need:


- Full school uniform (not PE kit) and sensible footwear. Trainers may be worn. Coats are advisable; however, as the tour is indoors for the most part, these may be left on the coach.
- A small bag containing essentials for the day
- A small purse/wallet to carry money or debit card
- A packed lunch and a packed tea. The tea will be stored separately on the coach and eaten on the homeward journey.

Packed meals should be clearly labelled and not include fizzy/energy drinks. For pupils in receipt of Free School Meals, a lunch will be ordered from the school kitchen. **Tea will not be provided for any pupil.** You may also wish to provide a mid-morning snack as we will not eat lunch until reaching the studios. Please remember that there are pupils in school with different allergies; therefore, please do not send any products that contain nuts or sesame seeds. Sweets may be taken on the trip, but these may not be eaten on the coach.

There is an extensive – and expensive – gift shop at the studio where children may buy reasonably priced items although we are not planning on this being a shopping trip! On this occasion, we are not recommending any maximum amount of spending money; however, please be aware that pupils will be responsible for any money taken at all times.

Mobile phones and electronic devices may be taken but must be used in accordance with the school policy.

- Phones must not be used for the purpose of sending messages, either to other pupils or parents, etc.
- Photographs should not be taken of any other child or member of staff, even if permission is granted. This is to ensure that we safeguard pupils and staff, at all times.

The usual school rules will apply and anyone not adhering to these will have their phone confiscated, as in the school policy. Photographs of pupils may be taken by staff using appropriate devices and in accordance with the school policy. Any use of social media, during the trip, will be treated seriously.

If your child requires medication, such as travel sickness tablets, please ensure that they are taken in good time for the outward journey. Tablets for the return journey should be **clearly labelled with your child's name and the dosage** and handed in to your child's group leader before leaving on the morning of the visit.

Finally, please remember that **we must leave promptly at 8am** and ask for pupils to arrive at school in good time. Staff will be in the bus bay from 7:45pm onwards. We are expected to return at approximately 8:00pm and a text message will be sent from school to parents, when we are within 30 minutes from school. **Please do not park in the bus bay or on the drive** as it is important that these remain clear for the coaches – and the children – to enter and leave safely.
