- **Dates:** Wednesday 31st March – Saturday 3rd April 2027

Allocating Places

There are **50 places available**. Priority will be given to pupils who have shown an excellent attitude to learning in Geography. If interest exceeds the number of places, we will use a **random draw** to allocate remaining spaces fairly. **The school's decision on the allocation of places will be final, and we ask that parents applying for a place respect this.**

Please note that submitting the form does not guarantee a place.

Successful pupils will be notified by **Friday 27th February 2026**.

Payments

For those allocated a place, the payment schedule will most likely be:

- **£200 deposit** via Parent Pay — due by **Wednesday 29th April 2026**
- **£150** to be paid in **May**
- **£150** to be paid in **June**
- **£150** to be paid in **July**
- **£150** to be paid in **September**
- **£150** to be paid in **October**
- **£150** to be paid in **November**

Please be aware that:

- The **deposit becomes non-refundable** unless a replacement pupil can be found.
- As departure nears, securing a replacement becomes increasingly difficult, and later payments may also be non-refundable depending on circumstances.

Passports & Travel Requirements

Each child must travel with **their own passport**, valid for at least **six months beyond our departure date**.

A **Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC)** is also required. This is free and can be applied for here:
