#### Start of the Autumn Term

A reminder we will be running a staggered start to our autumn term as follows –

We ask that pupils arrive on site no later than 8.50am each day so they can be sat in their seats ready for the start of the school day at 8.55am. Pupils who arrive after 8.55am will receive a late mark.
