Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Industrial Action

As you may be aware from the media the NEU have voted to go on strike on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> February, Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February, Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March. The unions are in dispute with the Secretary of State for Education.

We have now undertaken a thorough risk assessment alongside colleagues within the trust and will need to make the following arrangements on 1<sup>st</sup> February

- School will be closed to Year 7 and Year 8 and they should remain at home. Access to remote learning will be made available via the school website.
- School will be open to Year 6 and they should attend as normal
- Pupils with an EHCP or pending EHCP to attend school in all years
- We will have 30 places available for pupils in Year 7 and 8 whose parents are key workers. Pupils will access the same work as their peers working from home via our website and will be supervised by staff to do so. Please complete the booking form in the link below. Places are limited and will be awarded to the first 30 bookings; we ask parents to please consider carefully whether they require one of these spaces.


