Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our Year 7 Key Stage 3 History curriculum, we are going to visit Quarry Bank Mill in Styal, Cheshire. This will give the pupils an opportunity to see, hear and fully understand what life would have been like for children working during the Industrial Revolution.

The pupils will have a tour of the factory but they will also have a tour of the Apprentice House and have a talk on what life would have been like for children who were sold to the mills.

The visit will take place on Monday 22 May 2023. **The trip will leave school before morning registration and we will be returning after the end of the school day so pupils will not be back in time to catch the school buses. Pupils will need to be at school by 8.15 in the morning and we would aim to be back by 4pm.**

The cost of this visit is **£16.00** (including transport and insurance). This is a voluntary contribution to enable this visit to go ahead. No child shall be excluded from this visit should you not be able to contribute, however if we do not receive enough contributions then the trip cannot take place and will be cancelled. We recognise that, during the cost of living crisis, some families may not be able to contribute to this trip or may be able to pay a lower contribution, if this is the case then please complete the following form:

Payment and consent will need to be paid by Friday 12 May on ParentPay.
