Uniform Standards

As you know, at Scissett Middle School we have the very highest expectations of everybody connected to our school. One of the areas that we insist on is that every child follows our policies on uniform and appearance.

Whilst our Year 8 pupils only have 10 weeks remaining at Scissett Middle School, our expectations on uniform remain high. Pupils will also be expected to wear full school uniform for their two-week transition period at Shelley College in July.

The main issues which we continue to face from a significant minority of pupils are;

- Tight fitting, exceptionally short skirts.
- Trainers which are branded, with an increasing number of different colours.

Please be aware that we will be insisting that pupils change from these inappropriate items into acceptable school uniform in line with school policy which, will be provided by the pastoral team until appropriate items can be replaced from home.

Our expectations with regards to school uniform have not changed over the time your child has attended the school however, should you require any clarification, please contact your child's form teacher in the first instance or revisit the uniform policy via the link below.
